Playdough Mat Frog

Print out and laminate the frog playdough mat. Prepare a batch of play dough, colouring it either yellow or green to compliment the colour of the frog. Children are required to roll balls of playdough and squash the balls to cover the white dots on the playdough mat.

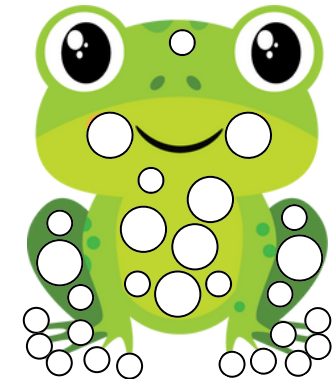
Playdough Recipe:

Playdough ingredients:

- 2 cups all-purpose flour (500ml)
- 3/4 cup salt (190ml)
- 4 teaspoons cream of tartar (20ml)
- 2 cups lukewarm water (500ml)
- 2 Tablespoons of vegetable oil (25ml)
- Food colouring
- Plastic storage bags and ice-cream container

Stir the flour, salt and cream of tartar together in a large pot. Next add the water, oil and colourant. Cook over medium heat, stirring constantly. Continue stirring until the dough has thickened and begins to form into a ball. Remove from heat, let it cool slightly and then knead the playdough until it is smooth.

The playdough will last for months if stored correctly. Store the playdough in a plastic bag and place this in a container with an airtight lid when not in use.
